



Help Keep Our Technicians Safe

At Calligaris Electronic Technologies, we have a responsibility and a commitment to protect our workers from critical injury. Our technicians must complete various safety training programs to provide them with the tools they need to work safe and comply with the law. Because they are exposed to various safety risks while working, we ask for your cooperation in helping us prevent potential hazards on their job site. All workers have the right to refuse unsafe work.

When a technician(s) is on premises for your installation, you can reduce the risk of injury or accident by following these guidelines.

1. Ensure the work site is clear of garbage, debris or hazardous material.
2. Do not move, climb or touch ladders used for the installation.
3. Do not climb or shake a tower structure while the technician is on the tower.
4. Stay clear of the work area while the technician is installing equipment at heights to avoid injury. Tools or equipment have the risk of falling down and causing head injury.
5. Do not use the technician's equipment.
6. Keep small children or pets away from the work area.
7. If you have guard dogs, please ensure they are restrained.

Weather Conditions: Our technicians cannot access roof areas during heavy rain, thunderstorms, freezing rain or snow. If there is ice, frost or snow on the roof your installation will be rescheduled. To prevent slips, keep walkways clear of ice .
